

**RESOLUTION NO. 2012-17**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VERNON, CALIFORNIA, CALLING FOR THE HOLDING OF A SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 5, 2012, FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AS REQUIRED BY THE PROVISIONS OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF VERNON.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Charter of the City of Vernon, a Special Municipal Election shall be held on June 5, 2012, for the election of Municipal Officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VERNON AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Pursuant to the requirements of the Charter of the City of Vernon, there is called and ordered to be held in the City of Vernon, California, on Tuesday, June 5, 2012, a Special Municipal Election for the purpose of electing one (1) Member of the City Council to fill the unexpired term of a City Council member which expires in 2014.

SECTION 2: The ballots to be used at the election shall be in a form and content as required by law.

SECTION 3: The City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to procure and furnish, if necessary, any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies, equipment and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and lawfully conduct the election.

SECTION 4: Pursuant to the City of Vernon Municipal Code, and other applicable provisions of the Charter of the City of Vernon and Ordinances of the City of Vernon, said Election shall be conducted pursuant to Chapter 2 of Division 4 (commencing with Section 4100) of

the California Elections Code only insofar as required by law, and only where not inconsistent with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Vernon. Notwithstanding Elections Code Section 4103, ballots cast in this Election shall be returned to the office of the Los Angeles County Registrar Office; and if to the City Clerk, no later than 8:00 o'clock p.m. on election day. If ballots are to be received in the office of the City Clerk, only those received by 8:00 o'clock p.m. on election day shall be counted. If the special election is not consolidated with the Statewide Direct Primary Election, then City Hall, located at 4305 Santa Fe Avenue, City of Vernon, is hereby designated as the polling place.

SECTION 5: The polls for the election shall be open at 7:00 o'clock a.m. of the day of the election and shall remain open continuously from that time until 8:00 o'clock p.m. of the same day when the polls shall be closed, pursuant to Election Code Section 10242, except as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

SECTION 6: In all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding municipal elections.

SECTION 7: Notice of the time and place of holding the election is given and the City Clerk is authorized, instructed and directed to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and manner as required by law.

SECTION 8: The City Clerk is directed to forward without delay to the County Election Department a certified copy of this resolution at the following address:

SECTION 9: The City Council of the City of Vernon authorizes the City Clerk to administer said election and all reasonable and actual election expenses shall be paid by the City upon presentation of a properly submitted bill.

SECTION 10: The City Clerk of the City of Vernon shall certify to the passage, approval and adoption of this resolution, and the City Clerk of the City of Vernon shall cause this resolution and the City Clerk's certification to be entered in the File of Resolutions of the Council of this City.


